The eight seats of software (meaning eight students can use the program on separate

computers at the same time) is valued at about \$10,000 and was developed by Tillsonburg's J.E. Bearing and Machine and In-House Solutions of Cambridge. The software will be used by EESS manufacturing technology students to design and manufacture parts on mills or lathes. Mr. Suffel estimated about 100 students from all grades would work with the new software.
